BEAUFORT Trash & Recycling Collection

WHAT IS CHANGING?

Waste Industries will begin garbage and recycling pickup for the Town this spring.

Delivery of the green 95-gallon roll-out carts for trash and blue 95-gallon carts for recycling will be announced. Attached to your cart will be information about the service, weekly trash collection day and every other week collection day for recycling.

The cost of this service is a flat rate of \$17 that is reflected in the monthly utility bill.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- Please bag all garbage before placing it in your trash cart. Everything must fit inside your cart(s) with the lid closed; no items of any sort sitting on top, beside or outside your cart(s) will be picked up. Carts must be curbside to be serviced (not in corrals); meaning the portion of the paved public street, right-of-way or traveled roadway adjacent to your property. Residents who live on private lanes/drives will need to place their cart(s) curbside of the closest public street to be serviced.
- Please place carts curbside the night before your pick up day or no later than 7 a.m. the morning of your pick up day. If a resident has a medical condition that restricts them from pulling their cart(s) curbside, contact Town Hall to request assistance. Special cart handling is available for residents that are elderly, injured, ill or handicapped and not capable of rolling the cart. The Town requires those residents requesting such special handling to obtain a doctor's certification or another verification acceptable to the Town that they are either permanently or temporarily requiring the special handling to roll out/in the cart.
- Once your cart(s) have been serviced, please remove them from the curbside and return them to your home.
- Extra carts are an additional \$10 per can for trash and \$4 for recycling per month. Contact Town Hall at 252-728-2141 for details.
- Residents are responsible for the cleaning, care and security of their carts. The Town will record the serial number of each cart assigned to your address and we recommend you do the same and keep them in a safe location. You will contact the Town to request a replacement cart, if needed. The Town will replace a cart at no charge only when damages are due to normal use. The Town will charge resident for carts replaced due to damages caused by improper use, burning or vandalizing and for destroyed, lost or stolen carts.

WHAT CAN I THROW AWAY?

Any solid waste, animal or plant material from the handling, preparation, processing, cooking, consumption or storage of food and other waste that can be disposed of in a sanitary landfill or transfer station generated by the normal day-to-day operation of a home, business and industrial, governmental or institutional establishments.

WHAT CAN I RECYCLE?

Aluminum and bi-metal food/beverage cans; clear, green or brown glass bottles and food jars; plastics #1 and #2 with an opening smaller than the base of the container, such as milk jugs, water jugs and soft drink bottles; detergent bottles excluding containers that held motor oil or corrosive liquids; and paper products such as newspapers, inserts, copy paper, notebook paper, stationary, computer paper, junk mail, shoe, soap and cereal boxes, corrugated cardboard and magazines.

WHAT DAY WILL RECYCLING BE COLLECTED?

Recycling is collected every other week. Check the packet distributed with your roll-out cart for your collection day.

WHAT ABOUT YARD DEBRIS AND BULK ITEMS?

- Public Works will begin collecting yard debris on the south side of Mulberry/Lennoxville on Monday and North side of Mulberry/Lennoxville on Tuesday after Waste Industries takes over regular household collection.
- When Waste Industries begins collecting household waste, you will need to schedule bulk item pickup. Call Town Hall or email publicworks@beaufortnc.org by 5 p.m. the Monday of the week you'd like the items collected. Check for a list of acceptable items on the website.
- Town will collect old trash cans and recycling containers this spring.
- * Trash schedules will remain consistent from week to week. Any changes in the schedule due to holidays or weather will be posted on the Town website.
