Dredging Projects

The Army Corps of Engineers has completed dredging of Bulkhead Channel "Range 1."



Subdivision Ordinance Amendments

Staff is drafting updates to the Subdivision Ordinance.

Cedar Street Paving

NCDOT is expected to install stormwater bioswales on Cedar Street this winter. The Town's application for funding for pervious concrete for the parking spaces is pending with an expected announcement in October. Paving will commence in the spring of 2023.

High Rate Infiltration Basin

Engineering is 90% complete on this project.

Harbor & Waterways Master Plan

The committee is preparing a presentation for the Board of Commissioners at the September Work Session meeting on Sept. 26.

Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ)/Division of Water Infrastructure

The Division of Water Infrastructure informed the Town of their approval of the Wastewater Pump Stations Improvements project for Pre-Construction Planning Grant funding in the amount of \$225,000. This funding is to be used for preliminary engineering of improvements to replacements of sewer pump station numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

Oceanview Cemetery

Performance of additional cleanup work in the Oceanview Cemetery has been scheduled with the contractor.

Old Burying Ground

Old Burying Ground is closed the week of Sept. 12 for maintenance.



Wayfinding
